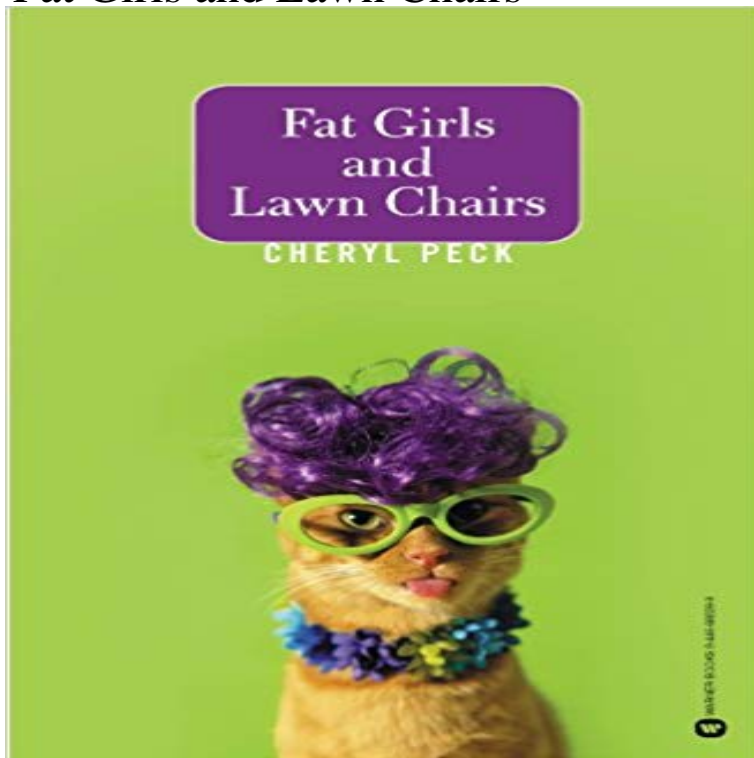


Fat Girls and Lawn Chairs
