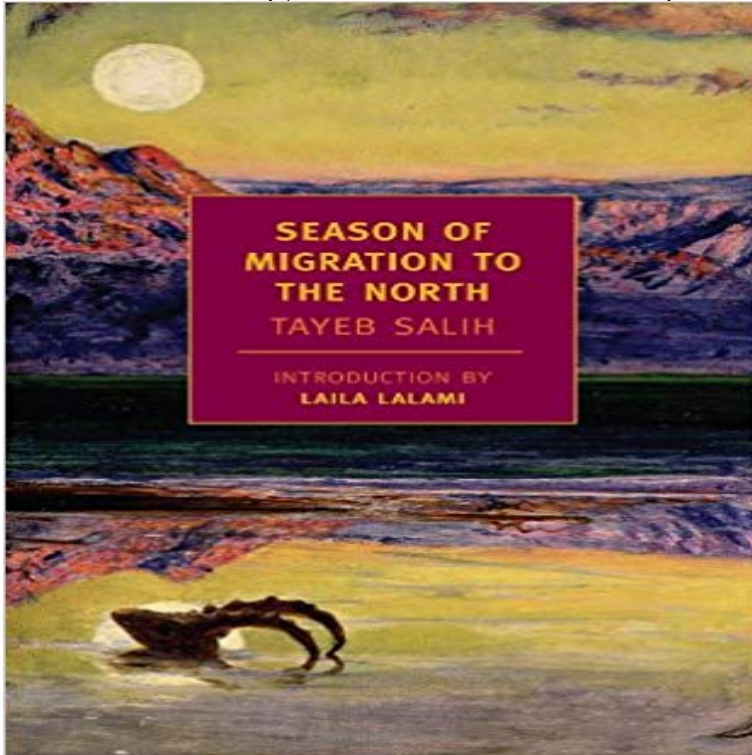


Season of Migration to the North (New York Review Books Classics)

In 2001 it was selected by a panel of Arab writers and critics as the most important Arab novel of the twentieth century.
