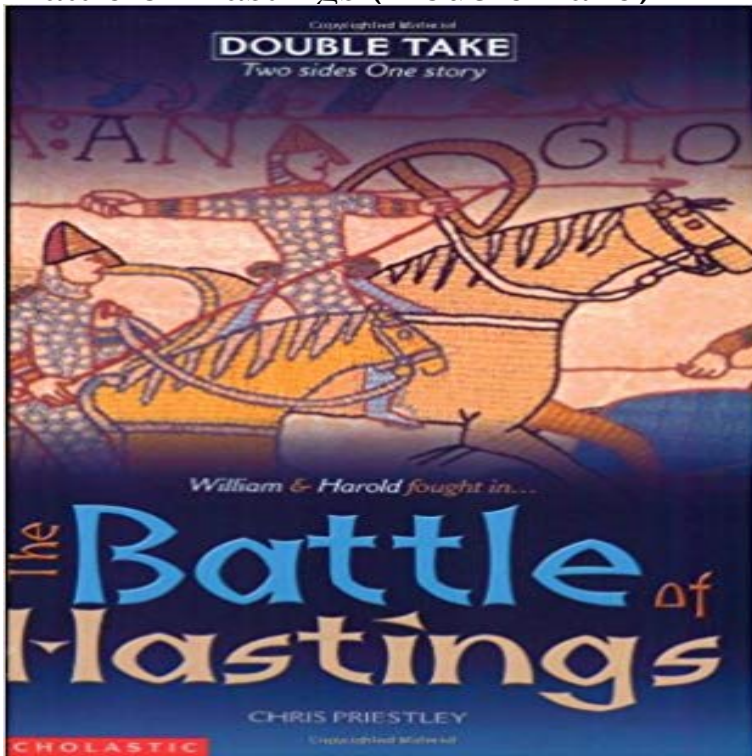


## Battle of Hastings (Double Take)
