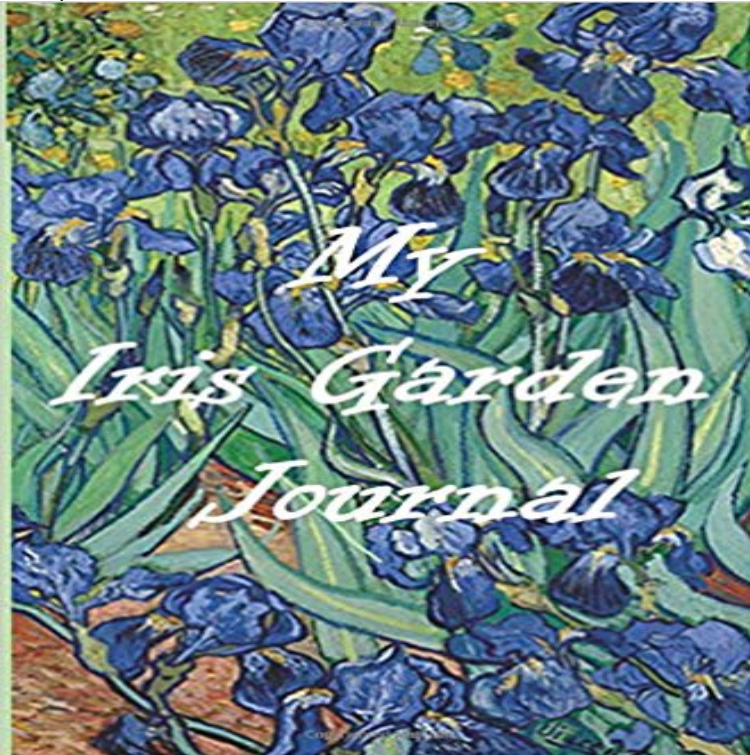


My Iris Garden Journal
