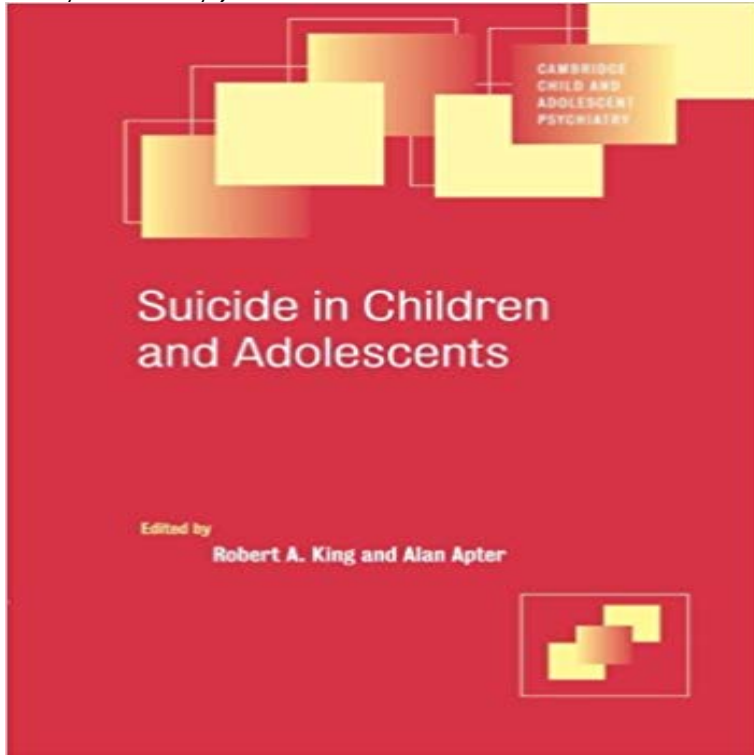


Suicide in Children and Adolescents (Cambridge Child and Adolescent Psychiatry)
