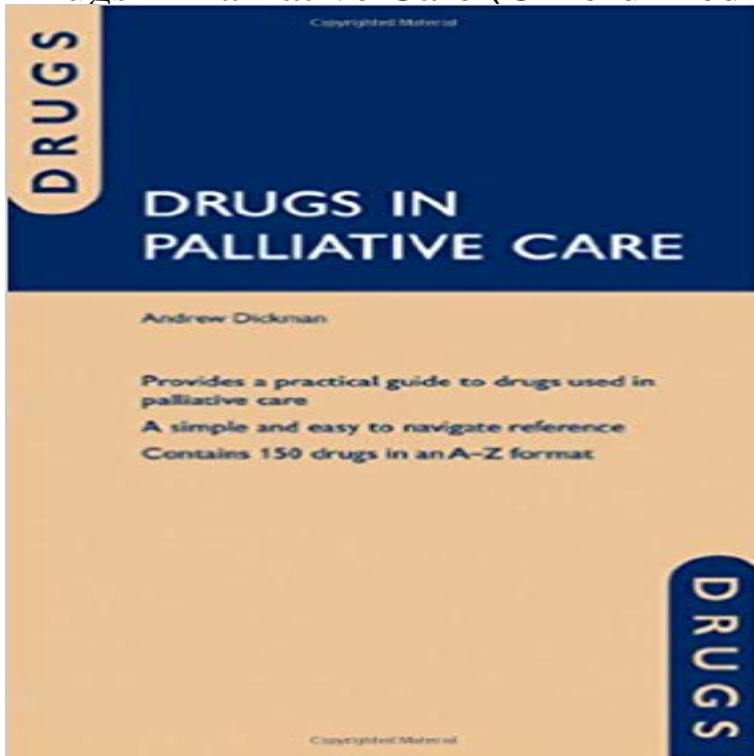


Drugs in Palliative Care (Oxford Medical Publications)
