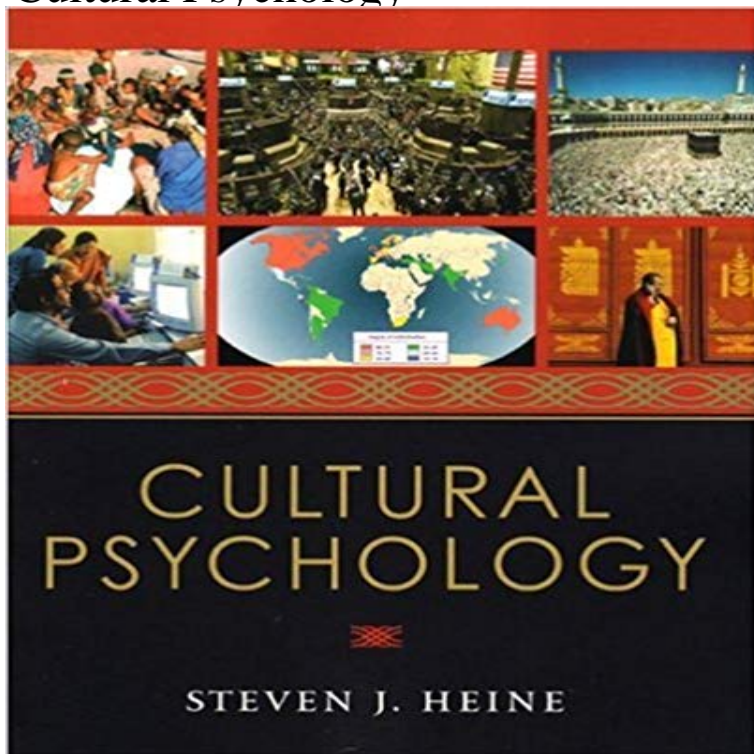


Cultural Psychology
